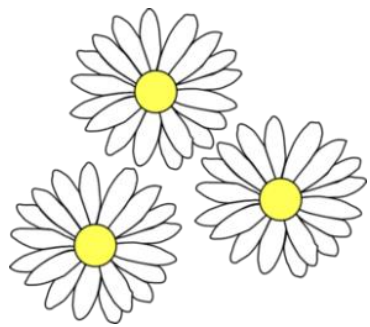
PRAYER requests
